### **INOAC Packaging Group Opens New Plant in Mexico**

The 110,000 square foot facility features six automated spray lines, a clean-room environment, and in the very near future will add vacuum metalizing capabilities. A full line of custom decorating services is also offered including spray frosting, hot stamping and silk screening.

The gloss spray comes in virtually any color and when applied gives the PET bottle or jar a rich, deep chrome-like appearance. As with all Inoac products, the gloss spray is highly durable and product resistant. It can also be silk screened or hot stamped. One client, Guerlain, has already taken advantage of this new process and Inoac anticipates several other clients to follow suit.

### **INOAC Packaging Group Unveils Unique Package for Anti-Aging Product**

(Bardstown, KY—February, 2008) – Inoac Packaging Group has recently developed a highly unique package used for an anti-aging serum product. The package offers a luxurious and expensive-looking design but the most unique aspect is how the package was developed. The outer shell is "insert molded" twice with no sinks, voids, or packing lines, thereby creating the ultra heavy walls. The bottle is then assembled into the molded shell and held in place with a collar. This process provides the ultra heavy wall and tight tolerances required by the customer. The entire package, including the overcap, is made from PET, which is an environmentally-friendly material.
